

Survey Results

We had a total of 204 responses to the CASE survey. As a reminder, here are the options listed on the survey:

- Option 1: Split/Replicate as proposed by the district
- Option 2: Move WAVE to LCI,
- Option 3: Move WAVE to CCI, and
- Option 4: Cap WAVE

Looking at overall sentiment (by ranking choices with a 5,3,2,1 weighted point system based on choice/ranking per survey), the results of the survey are Option 3, Option 2, Option 1, Option 4. The highest number of respondents selected Option 3, the next highest number of respondents selected Option 2, etc., with the lowest number of respondents choosing Option 4. These results remain consistent when controlling for responses to the other questions about children ages.

In addition to being last-place, Option 4 also had very strong negative sentiments, with 84 (41%) respondents listing it as their last choice (a 4).

Option 3 had the strongest positive scores and the least negative sentiment. 32% of respondents ranked it as 1st choice and only 4% scored it a 4. Option 3 was really “the winner” in this survey, although the percent difference between Option 3, Option 2 and Option 1 were minimal, that is, option 3 was not that much stronger than Option 2 and Option 1. However, when considering that both options 2 and 3 were for moving WAVE in its entirety to LCI or CCI, the majority of survey respondents wanted to keep WAVE students together on one campus (see breakdown by age group below). This survey did not gather some information that could be used to further refine the results (zoned school for example). A more rigorous and formal survey of parents could be very helpful in guiding CCISD to a positive future for the WAVE program.
