

## General history of the WAVE Replication with respect to CASE:

Thursday	10/20	A question is presented to SBAC with specific suggestions regarding two WAVE campuses.
Wednesday	11/9	District G/T Coordinator called a mtg with CASE - told us she was leaving the district; assured no decisions were being made about WAVE
Monday	11/14	Informed by a parent that "WAVE Replication" was on the school board's agenda - Red Flag
Wednesday	11/16	Sent formal letter from CASE to superintendent of curriculum and boundary committee about the proposal
Friday	11/18	Received formal response back from superintendent with draft proposal to "Replicate WAVE" that was recently given to the school board
Monday	11/21	CASE held town meeting sharing Information About Proposal To Split WAVE - approximately 55 people attended Began strongly encouraging everyone to email admin and board
Monday	11/28	Attended and spoke (9 minutes) at school board meeting against WAVE replication proposal and the districts reactionary fix to a problem unrelated to WAVE (a different campus not being fully utilized) – 105 WAVE parents/students attended the board meeting
Wednesday	11/30	Sent out parent survey..out of 800 emails, within 24 hours, 225 replied
Every day	11/28- now	Continue to encourage parents to talk, email, call the admin and board.
Friday	12/9	Meeting with administration to discuss proposal and concerns
Monday	12/12	Admin is presenting proposal to board
